Patterns of Evidence: The Exodus – video

On Sunday, October 30 at 6:30pm come for a fascinating documentary called *Patterns of Evidence: the Exodus*, an in-depth investigation by filmmaker Tim Mahoney about what the hard evidence really has to say about the foundational story of the Old Testament: the Exodus out of Egypt. After examining the details in the biblical text, he journeys across the globe to search for patterns of evidence firsthand. The result is the most in-depth archaeological investigation into the Exodus from Egypt ever captured on film.

COMMUNION



Hawkwood Baptist Church shares in the Lord's Supper on the second Sunday of each month. If you are a Christian and have examined your heart, you are welcome to participate. Following is a brief history and explanation of the Lord's Supper. "Christians by the sacred use of bread and wine, are to commemorate together the dying love of Christ; preceded always by solemn self-examination. We call it the Lord's Supper; Christians have also called it communion (from the Latin communion, sharing in common, because of our sharing with Christ and with each other) and the Eucharist (from the Greek word "eucharistia" for "thanksgiving" because Jesus took the bread and "gave thanks" before he broke it."¹ The Lord's Supper also reminds us that because Jesus gave His life for us, nothing can separate us from His love. 1 Corinthians 11:28 says, "Let a person examine himself, then, and so eat of the bread and drink of the cup."

1 Corinthians 11:23-26 (HCSB)

23 For I received from the Lord what I also passed on to you: On the night when He was betrayed, the Lord Jesus took bread, 24 gave thanks, broke it, and said, "This is My body, which is for you. Do this in remembrance of Me." 25 In the same way, after supper He also took the cup and said, "This cup is the new covenant established by My blood. Do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of Me." 26 For as often as you eat this bread and drink the cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until He comes.
